#### Four killed in massive fire at Delhi's Shastri Nagar

**NEW DELHI:** Two children among four people have been killed after a massive fire broke out in a residential building in the Shastri Nagar area of Shahdara in New Delhi in the early hours of Thursday. According to the police officials, a total of nine people, including three men, four women, and two children, were rescued and have been shifted to a nearby hospital. "We received information from the hospital that four people, including two children and a married couple, died due to suffocation," a senior police officer said. "The police received a call at Geeta Colony Police Station about a major fire at Shastri Nagar, near Geeta Colony, at around 5:30 a.m. We immediately informed the Delhi fire service department, and four fire tenders, a police team, ambulances, and PCR vans were rushed to the spot," he said.

#### Farmers protest at Delhi's Ramliia Maidan, raise slogans against Centre

**NEW DELHI:** Farmers in large numbers gathered at the Ramliia Ground here on Thursday to take part in a "Kisan Mazdoor Mahapanchayat" that has been convened to protest against the BJP-led Centre's policies regarding the farming sector. The Samyukta Kisan Morcha (SKM), an umbrella body of farmer organisations that spearheaded a protest at Delhi's borders in 2020-21 against three agriculture laws that have since been repealed, has said a resolution will be passed at the "Kisan Mazdoor Mahapanchayat" to "intensify the fight" against the Centre's policies. The farmers raised slogans against the Centre at the protest venue. Police have issued a traffic advisory for commuters to avoid the roads leading to central Delhi.

#### Suspended Cong MP Preet Kaur joins BJP

**NEW DELHI:** Suspended Congress MP from Patiala Preet Kaur joined the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) here on Thursday ahead of the Lok Sabha Election. She joined the party in the presence of BJP General Secretary Vinod Tawade, Tarun Chug, BJP State President, and Party's Punjab President Sunil Kumar Jakhar and other senior leaders. Talking to the media after joining the party, Preet Kaur said, "I will work for my state and the country under the leadership of PM Modi". "I had a good innings with the Congress party and I hope I'll have a better innings with the BJP", she added. Preet Kaur, wife of former Punjab CM Amarinder Singh, was suspended by the Congress in February 2023 on the allegations of engaging in activities contrary to the party's interests. Since then, Preet had openly aligned herself with the saffron party in her stronghold of Patiala.

## LS Polls: AAP releases first list of 8 candidates for Punjab Five Cabinet ministers fielded

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Punjab on Thursday announced the first list of eight candidates, including five Cabinet ministers, for the upcoming Lok Sabha election. According to the list released by the AAP, the popular name of the Punjabi film industry Karamjit Anmol will contest from Faridkot. Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal will be the party candidate from Amritsar, Laljit Singh Bhullar from Khadur Sahib, Sushil Kumar Rinku from Jalandhar, Gurpreet Singh GP from Fatehgarh Sahib, Gurmeet Singh Khudian from Bathinda, Gurmeet Singh Meet Hayer from Sangur and Dr Balbir Singh from Patiala. On February 27, the Aam Admi Party had announced its candidates for four Lok Sabha seats in Delhi and one from Haryana's Kurukshetra constituency. It has fielded Kuldeep Kumar from the East Delhi constituency, whereas former Delhi Minister and senior AAP leader Somnath Bharti

will contest from the New Delhi Lok Sabha seat. The party has fielded Sahiram Palwal from the South Delhi seat, and Mahabab Mishra is set to contest from West Delhi. In Haryana, AAP has decided to field Sushil Gupta will contest from Kurukshetra. There are 13 Lok Sabha seats in Punjab with four seats reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC) candidates. In the 2019 Lok Sabha Elections, the Congress-led UPA alliance clinched 8 seats, while the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) managed to secure four. The AAP, which was contesting for the first time in the state won one seat. AAP is the first party in the state to have announced its candidates for the upcoming general elections.

## Kejriwal moves Sessions Court challenging summons issued to him on ED complaints

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has moved the Sessions Court challenging summons issued to him by Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate on ED complaints for not complying with the summons issued by the central probe agency in the Delhi liquor policy money laundering case. The Special Judge, Rakesh Syal, is scheduled to

hear the matter this afternoon. Last week, the Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate took cognizance of the Enforcement Directorate's second complaint and issued a fresh summons to Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal for his personal appearance before the court on March 16, 2024. ED recently moved the court with a second complaint for allegedly not complying with the summons in



the alleged Delhi liquor policy money laundering case. The Enforcement Directorate has moved that a second complaint has been filed against Arvind Kejriwal under Section 190 (1)(a) CrPC r/w section 200 CrPC 1973 r/w section 174 IPC, 1860 r/w section 63 (4) of PMLA, 2002 for non-attendance in compliance with Section 50, PMLA, 2002. Earlier too, the ED filed a complaint against Arvind Kejriwal in which the court issued a summons to him in

the matter. Following the summons order, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal appeared virtually before the court on the ED's complaint against him for allegedly non-compliance with the summons order. Arvind Kejriwal, while appearing, virtually informed the court that he wanted to join the court proceedings physically but due to the confidence motion and budget sessions, he couldn't come physically before the court.

## Women scientists played major role in Mission Divyastra's success

Showcasing the increasing role of women in the field of science in the country, a large number of female scientists were involved in the success of the Mission Divyastra led by the Programme Director Sheena Rani. Senior scientist Sheena Rani has been involved in many successful missile tests in the past also. The programme project director Dr Shankari S also played a significant role in the mission's success, defence officials said. A significant number of female scientists worked in the programme to develop key tech-

nologies for the mission to develop the multiple independently targetable re-entry vehicle (MIRV) technology for the Agni-5 missile. The female scientists who played a significant role in the project include Usha Verma, Neeraja, Vijay Lakshmi and Venkatamani and all of them are part of the strategic missiles laboratories of the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO). Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday stated that India successfully carried out the maiden flight test of the Agni-5 missile with multiple independently targetable re-entry vehicle (MIRV) technology, which would allow the weapon system to deliver multiple nuclear warheads against different targets spread across hundreds of kilometres.

## Two prisoners' group clash in Gurdaspur jail, police personnel also attacked, four injured

Panic spread in Central Jail Gurdaspur after two groups of prisoners clashed with each other and four personnel were injured. During this time, the policemen who came to intervene were also injured. According to the information received, there was a fight among the prisoners present in the jail in Central Jail Gurdaspur over some issue. The fighting between two groups of prisoners escalated so much that the district police had to resort to aerial firing. Some prisoners were injured during the fight. During this time the prisoners also attacked the policemen and injured them. The policemen injured in the attack include Jodha Singh Constable Jail and Mandeep Singh. SHO Dhariwal, ASI.

Jagdeep Singh, Havildar Baljinder Singh were also injured, who were admitted to Civil Hospital Gurdaspur. Due to this incident, later SSP of district Gurdaspur, SSP of Batala and SSP of Pathankot also reached the jail along with other top officials along with heavy police force. Ambulance vehicles were also called inside the jail so that the injured could be taken for treatment. Police contingents were called in to control conditions in the prison. Till the time of writing the news, the exact reason for this incident could not be known nor did any police officer give information on this subject.

## Centre asks states to ban 23 breeds of "Ferocious" dogs

The central government has directed states to ban the sale and breeding of 23 breeds of ferocious dogs, including Pitbull Terrier, American Bulldog, Rottweiler and Mastiffs, amid rising instances of pet dog attacks. The directive issued to states and Union Territories bars people from keeping as many as 23 breeds of dogs as pets. The Centre also said that these breeds of dogs, which have already been kept as



pets, should be sterilised to prevent further breeding.

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying

said it has received representations from citizens, citizen forums and Animal Welfare Organisations to ban some of the breeds of dogs from keeping them as pets and other purposes. The panel has identified 23 breeds of dogs, including mixed and cross breeds, as ferocious and also dangerous for human lives. Pitbull Terrier, Tosa Inu, American Staffordshire Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Dogo Argentino, American Bulldog, Boerboel Kangal, Central Asian Shepherd Dog and Caucasian Shepherd Dog are

among the breeds sought to be banned from the Centre. Other breeds include South Russian Shepherd Dog, Tornjak, Sarplaninac, Japanese Tosa and Akita, Mastiffs, Terriers, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Wolf Dogs, Canario, Akbash Dog, Moscow Guard Dog, Cane Corso and Bandog. "The above dog breeds, including crossbreeds, shall be prohibited for import, breeding, selling as pet dogs and other purposes," the letter said, quoting the recommendations of the expert panel.

Chairing a state level virtual meeting with the District Public Relations Officers (DPROs) here today, the Chief Electoral Officer said that the Commission has issued strict instructions to monitor the advertisements, publicity of candidates and paid news cases. He said that for this the district level Media Certification and Monitoring Committees have been constituted with the DPROs as their nodal officers. Mr. Sibin C asserted that these committees have been mandated to keep a strict vigil over the news content in news channels, social media platforms as well as news papers.

The Chief Electoral Officer asked all the DPROs to perform their duty diligently to check such news content and subsequently report the paid news, if any, to the com-



cerned Returning Officers (ROs). He envisioned that the committee will keep watch on poll-related news, features and advertisements appearing in print, electronic and social media during the run up of polls. Mr. Sibin C said that the committee will be responsible for certification of advertisements, monitoring of news in print, social and electronic media along with keeping records of all election-related news of candidates in the fray.

The Chief Electoral Officer said that the constitution of these committees have a huge significance as they will help in effective monitoring and accounting of the poll-related expenditure incurred by the candidates. He also asked the DPROs to ensure that the committee members verify the advertising contents sought to be published by political parties, the candidates or their supporters before releasing them to the media. Mr. Sibin C reiterated the commitment of the Election Commission to ensure free, fair and peaceful Lok Sabha polls in the state adding that any violation of the model code of conduct by political parties would also be monitored, he added.

The Chief Electoral Officer said that the DPROs should combat the new challenge of advertisement on social media platforms deftly and no stone should be left unturned for it. He said that in today's era Social Media has transformed into a major tool for information dissemination due to which special thrust must be laid on scrutiny of these platforms.

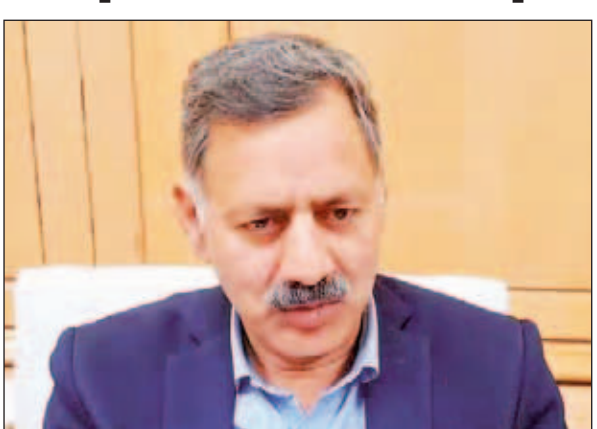

Krishni Vigyan Kendra Hoshiarpur, the district-level extension agency of Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana organized a field day centered around wheat cultivation using the Smart Seeder in village Dhada Kalan, block Garhshankar, district Hoshiarpur on March 13, 2024.

In village Dhada Kalan, KVK Hoshiarpur associated, progressive farmer, S. Taranjit Singh Mann undertook wheat sowing with PAU Smart Seeder on 18 acres for the first time, following expert guidance from KVK scientists. Dr. Maninder Singh Bons, Associate Director (Training), KVK Hoshiarpur in his address underscored the imperative need to for-



sake residue burning for the preservation of environment. He elucidated the adverse consequences of crop residue burning and rallied farmers to actively champion the cause of non-burning of paddy residue.

Dr. Bons advocated for a cost-effective and uncomplicated technique for in-situ paddy residue management, particularly beneficial for the timely sowing of wheat. Furthermore, he imparted valuable insights into pest management strategies in residue managed fields.

During the programme, KVK experts delivered tech-

nical lectures for the benefit of the farmers. Dr. Ajaib Singh, Assistant Professor (Agricultural Engineering) elucidated to the farmers that the PAU Smart Seeder meticulously places wheat seeds within a finely tilled narrow band of soil and diligently covers the seed rows with soil using furrow closing rollers. This innovative machine can be efficiently operated with a tractor boasting 45 to 50 horsepower. Dr. Ajaib Singh also shared that the machine's field capacity is 1 acre of wheat sowing per hour and fuel consumption rate is 5.5 liters per acre.

The maximalist dream of the so-called INDIA alliance, involving the complete seat coordination of all parties opposed to the Bharatiya Janata Party, was never likely to be a reality in West Bengal. In this state, where the BJP has traditionally never had much of a foothold, it was always impossible to conceive of any electoral alliance that involved the ruling All India Trinamul Congress and its age-old adversary, the Communist Party of India (Marxist). Even so, the beleaguered liberal ecosystem centred on the national capital had always hoped that an understanding of sorts involving Rahul Gandhi, M.K. Stalin in Tamil Nadu and Mamata Banerjee would have a symbolic importance in a general election in which Prime Minister Narendra Modi is threatening to run away with all the prizes.

Last Sunday, at yet one more of those stupendously large public meetings for which West Bengal is famous, the mercurial AITC supremo snuffed the life out of the INDIA alliance in a very dramatic way. She announced the names of AITC candidates from all the 42 Lok Sabha seats of West Bengal, including the two seats held by the Congress. On its part, the Congress uttered a feeble protest against Mamata Banerjee's 'unilateral' declaration but it could not conceal the fact that the oh-so-clever alliance, whose naamakaran was said to be the handiwork of the Bengali poet-politician, was now dead, publicly strangled before lakhs of witnesses in Calcutta.

Whether the oozing self-confidence of the chief minister and her nephew is warranted will be known once the results of the election are out. However, judging from the speeches of the Banerjee duo at the meeting, some conclusions are warranted. First, in resurrecting her 2021 assembly poll plank of being the party of Bengal against outsiders, the AITC made it sufficiently clear that it was fighting the general election to hold on to a regional space. Secondly, the AITC's shrill insistence that the Modi government at the Centre had short-changed West Bengal in welfare payments was at one with the protest politics that had been a feature of Left politics in the state from 1977 to 2011. Mamata Banerjee's indictment of a venal imperial power in Delhi was a melodramatic carbon copy of the gripes associated with Jyoti Basu and past generations of venerable bhadralok Marxists.

Decoding the speeches of the AITC top guns is no rocket science. The underlying assertion that the mantle of Swami Vivekananda, Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar, Raja Rammohan Roy and Rabindranath Tagore had fallen on the Banerjee family of Kalighat could well be inspirational. It could also bolster the younger Banerjee's claim that each of the 42 AITC candidates represent Bengal, no less.

# Role of cholesterol in pain perception

When you stub your toe or hit your head, you know that rubbing the area can help relieve the pain. But how? New research from the work of Scott B. Hansen, Ph.D., demonstrates how physical pressure on cells may reduce pain signals, whereas excessive cholesterol clumps in cell membranes can interfere with that.

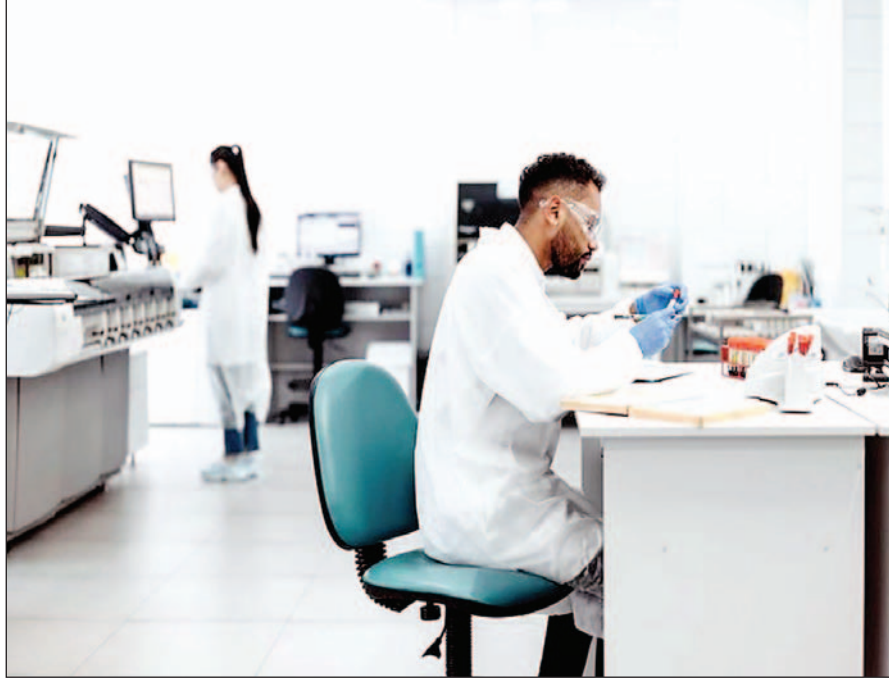
The research, carried out at The Herbert Wertheim UF Scripps Institute for Biomedical Innovation & Technology, appears in the scientific journal *eLife*. Hansen and his colleagues' discoveries are important for several reasons. They show for the first time that cell membrane lipids, or fats, help send an electrical pulse into cells after experiencing pressure and force. The research illuminates the path that pain signals take from an injury site to the brain, and connects the many biological players involved. Importantly, the research shows how excess cholesterol in cell membranes may interfere with pain control.

"Excess cholesterol is a feature in many diseases and disorders, including diabetes and diseases of aging," said Hansen, an associate professor of molecular medicine at The Wertheim UF Scripps Institute. "This could be one explanation for why we see more chronic pain in these groups."

The study also adds to mounting evidence that the fatty molecules that make up cell membranes require structure to perform their many duties, he added.

"Originally, science thought only proteins had structures with function," said Hansen. "It looks like the lipids can be added to that list."

A cell is made of a fatty exterior membrane encasing a water-based interior. Ad-



vanced microscopes and other new technologies are revealing that the cell membrane isn't simply a fatty sac, though. Rather, it's a sophisticated collection of sensors, pores, channels, receptors and cholesterol clumps held in place by precisely arranged fat molecules.

"There are two types of fats in the membrane, one is fluid, like olive oil, and a second contains cholesterol and is found as tiny, rigid clumps, more like lard," Hansen

said. "It wasn't known that those fats might play a role in pain signaling."

To feel pain, first, the injury must be sensed. Second, that injury message must convert to a signal that can travel rapidly through the body and be interpreted by the brain. The lipid structure appears to sense the force and convert it into a signal. The signal can then help activate the body's own pain-relieving responses -- so long as there's no interference -- lessening pain's severity.

Scientists have previously documented the role of a mechanical force-sensing enzyme called PLD2 in these steps and its ability to activate a pain-relief providing potassium channel called TREK-1. Missing was an understanding of how PLD2 and TREK-1 could be activated by the membrane. PLD2 lacked the ability to sense tension, the typical way that mechanosensors are engaged. Membrane lipids weren't considered, perhaps because they were poorly understood, due to technical limitations.

"Until recently, the study of these cholesterol-containing lipid clumps, also called lipid rafts, has been difficult, because they are too small to be seen by a regular light microscope," Hansen said.

Using a special microscope, Hansen and colleagues documented in several cell types that pressure and stretching, or "shear," caused changes to those fat molecules that temporarily altered the cell's ability to activate pain relief.

Studies in mice and fruit flies also underscored their findings.

The research raises interesting questions and opportunities for more study, Hansen said. Many proteins associate with these lipid structure, including the proteins involved in Alzheimer's disease and inflammation. Understanding whether inflammation affects membrane cholesterol structure, especially in brain cells, may also prove important to understanding the pain-inflammation link.

"New types of non-opioid pain therapeutics are urgently needed for people who live with chronic pain," Hansen said. "Understanding what factors set the threshold for pain is an important step toward that goal."

### European Union lawmakers approve law to limit use of AI

European Union lawmakers on Wednesday gave final approval to a landmark law governing artificial intelligence (AI) to limit its use in businesses and organizations in Europe for everything from health care decisions to policing, CNN reported.

The first-of-its-kind law imposes blanket-bans some "unacceptable" uses of the technology while enacting stiff guardrails for other applications deemed "high-risk."

The EU AI Act outlaws social scoring systems powered by AI and any biometric-based tools used to guess a person's race, political leanings or sexual orientation.

It also bans the use of AI to interpret the emotions of people in schools and workplaces, as well as some types of automated profiling intended to predict a person's likelihood of committing future crimes.

The law further outlines a separate category of "high-risk" uses of AI, particularly for education, hiring and access to government services, and imposes a separate set of transparency and other obligations on them, CNN reported.

Companies such as OpenAI that produce powerful, complex and widely used AI models will also be subject to new disclosure requirements under the law.

It also requires all AI-generated deep fakes to be clearly labelled, targeting concerns about manipulated media that



could lead to disinformation and election meddling.

The sweeping legislation, which is set to take effect in roughly two years, highlights the speed with which EU policymakers have responded to the exploding popularity of tools such as OpenAI's ChatGPT.

The legislation approved by a plenary vote in the European Parliament this week is the result of a proposal that was first introduced in 2021, which gave lawmakers a head start when the release of ChatGPT spurred an investment boom and public frenzy.

### Pak National Assembly recognises 'injustice' in Zulfikar Ali Bhutto's conviction

The National Assembly convened Wednesday to pass a pivotal resolution, acknowledging the trial and subsequent conviction of former Prime Minister and Pakistan People's Party (PPP) founder, Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, as "a gross miscarriage of justice," as reported by ARY News.

Following the recent announcement of the Supreme Court's reserved opinion on the presidential reference concerning the contentious death sentence imposed on Zulfikar Ali Bhutto, it was declared that the former Prime Minister was deprived of a "fair trial."

Led by Chief Justice of Pakistan (CJP) Qazi Faez Isa, a nine-judge bench delivered its verdict on the long-debated presidential reference, addressing whether it could reassess its decision, a matter deemed significant by PPP and legal experts as a historical injustice, ARY News reported.

Presented by PPP MNA Shazia Marri, the resolution urged the federal government to officially designate the first elected Prime Minister of Pakistan as 'Shaheed' (martyr) and 'National Democratic Hero.'

It also acknowledged the efforts of "Begum Nusrat Bhutto Sahiba, Shaheed Mohatma Benazir Bhutto, and PPP workers who sacrificed their lives to establish this truth."

Moreover, the resolution commended the "determination" exhibited by President Asif Ali Zardari in filing the presidential reference to reopen the case twelve years ago, along with Bilawal Bhutto Zardari's unwavering pursuit. The resolution applauded the Supreme Court of Pakistan for finally acknowledging and accepting the "glaring in-



justice" inflicted upon Shaheed Bhutto forty-four years ago.

In light of the Supreme Court's ruling, the resolution demanded the reversal of the unjust verdict in the Zulfikar Ali Bhutto case. Furthermore, it called for the establishment of the "Nishan-e-Zulfikar Ali Bhutto" award to honor individuals who have fought and sacrificed for true democracy in Pakistan.

Zulfikar Ali Bhutto received a death sentence during the tenure of former military dictator General (retired) Ziaul Haq. Charged with the murder of political rival Nawab Mohammed Ahmed Qasuri, Bhutto underwent a trial that captured international attention.

Despite appeals for clemency and mercy from numerous Heads of States, Bhutto was executed on April 4, 1979, marking a significant chapter in Pakistan's political history, ARY News reported.

Turns again home. Twilight and evening bell,

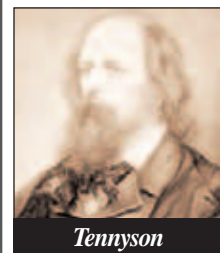

# Simple trick can improve accuracy of plant genetics research

Researchers have published a simple approach that increases the accuracy of techniques used to understand how environmental factors, such as temperature, impact gene activity in plants.

"There are really two contributions here," says Colleen Doherty, corresponding author of a paper on the work and an associate professor of molecular and structural biochemistry at North Carolina State University. "First, we're raising the visibility of a problem that many of us in the plant research community



were unfamiliar with, as well as highlighting the solution. Second, we've demonstrated that addressing this problem can make a significant difference in our understanding of gene activity in plants."

The technology at question is RNA-seq analysis, which measures changes in gene activity, or when genes are actively transcribing to generate proteins.

"We use RNA-seq analysis to assess how plants respond to various stimuli, or changes in their environment," Doherty says. "It's used widely because it's

a relatively easy and inexpensive way to monitor plant responses."

For example, researchers can use RNA-seq analysis to see which genes are turned on when a plant is experiencing drought conditions, which then informs the development of new plant varieties that are drought resistant.

But there's a specific challenge related to RNA-seq analysis, which Doherty and her collaborators ran into by accident. "We were monitoring how plants respond to different temperatures at multiple times of day, and the results we

got were wildly divergent," Doherty says. "We initially thought we might be doing something wrong. But when we began looking into it, we learned that animals and yeasts are known to have global changes in transcription based on variables such as the time of day or nitrogen deprivation."

In other words, researchers want to see how specific variables - such as increased temperature - affect transcription in specific genes. But there are some variables - like time of day - that can increase or decrease transcription in all

the genes.

This can throw off researchers' ability to draw conclusions about the specific variables they want to study. "Luckily, we found that this problem is sufficiently well-established among researchers who work on non-plant species that they have developed a method to account for it, called an artificial spike-in," Doherty says.

"These and similar techniques have been used in plant science in other contexts and when using older techniques and technologies.

## Every class is happy in BJP rule: Sultan Azran



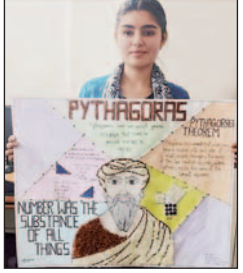

## Poor quality of construction material sparks row

Substandard material is being used in the construction of the park in Budiya town of Ward No. 4 of Jagadhri. The official said that the poor quality bricks that had arrived by mistake would be replaced. A grant amount of Rs 33 lakh was given by former CM Manohar Lal Khattar for the construction of a park on the land adjacent to the water reservoir in Budiya. But this land adjacent to cultivable land was very high, for which four walls were built on top of big walls and due to heavy rains and no drainage of water, the park got flooded in the east-north direction. The boundary wall fell. In this, along with the park, beautification with plants has also been shown on paper, whereas no sapling has been planted on the land till date. Gombir, Somnath, Karan Singh and Jal Singh Saini told that in the year 2018, a stone in the name of former CM Khattar, Mayor Madan Chauhan and MLA Ghanshyam Das Arora was installed at the gate of Jal Ghar along with Rashi. Due to substandard materials like bricks, rebar, cement and sand etc. corruption of corporation officials came to light. Masons em-



ployed on the spot themselves are saying that the bricks have come of substandard quality and they will work as per order. Passersby Ajay Jogi, Kamal Nath Saini, Rajesh Kashyap, Sajid Chauhan and Rajan Sharma told that after corruption of Rs 33 lakh, now after 5 years a budget of about Rs 35 lakh has been passed and the four fallen walls are being rebuilt. It has been a situation in which again and again old and poor quality bricks are being used and the MLA, no officer, the present Mayor and the MC do not go to the spot and see what is being messed with the comfort and convenience of the public. Outgoing MC Devendra Singh said that I will come to the spot and see that if anything is going wrong then the officials will

be questioned and if construction is being done with substandard material then I will get action taken and will not allow any wrong to happen to the public. Municipal Corporation's ME Muneshwar Singh said that the four walls of the park are being constructed by the contractor at a cost of approximately Rs 35 lakh. One heap is of top bricks and two heaps of loose bricks had arrived which will be returned and if the construction work has been done with substandard material then the contractor's payment will be deducted. When Yamunanagar MLA Ghanshyam Das was talked to, he said that it is the job of the officers and not the MLA to look after the discarded bricks and substandard material.
